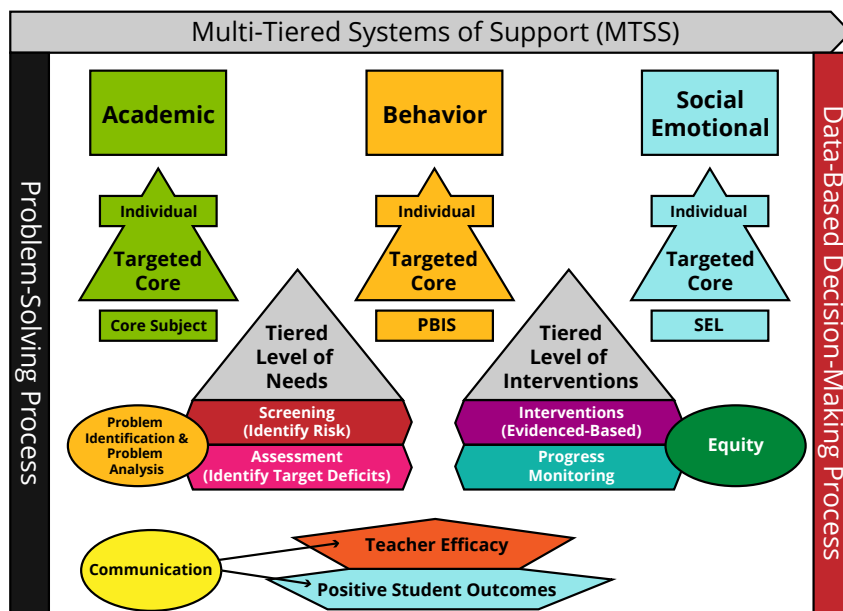

It is an arduous process to effectively construct, implement, and evaluate the efficacy of a Multi-Tiered System of Supports as gaps can occur any time you develop support structures or adjust existing ones. Oftentimes, exploring an alternative perspective, consulting with experts, networking with colleagues, and/or getting immediate feedback on your efforts can help ensure you're implementing your new systems with efficacy. This MTSS coaching series will provide that guidance (and much more).

During these coaching sessions, small groups will be able to evaluate their current MTSS/SEL/Behavior structures for strengths and gaps. The coaching sessions will provide opportunities to discuss the varying aspects of building an MTSS structure of support.

The MTSS Coaching Series provides an opportunity for District Teams and/or Specialists to participate in a coaching partnership to improve a district's systematic MTSS development, implementation, and evaluation.

Participants will have access to an MTSS coach for ten one-hour coaching sessions, handouts for all three MTSS series webinars (MTSS 4-Part Series, Behavior 4-Part Series, and SEL 4-Part Series), an MTSS resource guide with recommendations, and coaching framework guides (Needs Assessment Guide, Strategic Action Planning Guide, and Progress Monitoring Guide).

The MTSS coach will use the Coaching Framework (below) as a working foundation for each of the coaching sessions. Each coaching session will be structured around what is working, what needs adjusting, what needs to be removed, and what needs to be added. The coach will serve as a guide and facilitator, not a consultant. We believe that to build a district's capacity to implement an effective MTSS framework, partner reflection activities are necessary to move beyond the consultant relationship and require tremendous internal work by the partner. We do not want to give you the answers, we want to help you find them.

MTSS Coaching Framework: Reflection, Action, and Evaluation

Needs Assessment (Asking the right questions)

- *What are your specific needs?*
 - Action Planning (Strategic)
- *What are your strategic action steps?*
 - Progress Monitoring (Data Collection)
- *Is it working?*
 - Evaluation (Efficacy)
- *What worked and what needs to be adjusted?*
